

# Palm Sunday

The King is Coming!

## Matthew 12:38-45

### Outline of the Passage:

1. **There's No Need to Argue**

The death, burial and resurrection of Jesus is the sign that settles every argument. It tells you everything you need to know about why and how you need to believe in Jesus.

2. **We're All Equal Before God**

Some people have a head-start in how they get to hear about Jesus, but ultimately we have the same need of salvation and the same choice to make – will we believe in Jesus?

3. **Choices Have Consequences**

Our choice about how we'll respond to Jesus has consequences in this life and the next. Those consequences will either be awesome or awful! How will you respond to Jesus? How are you giving other people the opportunity to believe in Him?

### Discussion Questions:

1. Do you agree that the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus is the ultimate sign that tells us everything we need to know in order to be saved? *(Hint: you might like to check out 1 Corinthians 15:1-11!)*
2. Good Friday is this week! What are some ways that we can share the news of Jesus' death, burial and resurrection with others when we can't gather together as we normally would?
3. Do you ever think of some people as more likely or less likely to be saved by God? What would be modern equivalents of the people of Nineveh or the Queen of Sheba? How does that affect our willingness to openly share the message about Jesus?
4. How does an awareness of the consequences of accepting or rejecting Jesus affect you?
5. What does Jesus' example in this passage teach you about how to help people respond to Him in faith?
